From Nagpur to Malé: Another Step in Our Global Water Journey

We are proud to share another milestone in Microfilter Polymers' journey: the successful installation and commissioning of a 75 KLD Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) in Malé, Maldives. For us, this project is about more than installing a treatment plant. It represents the trust placed in an Indian water-treatment company to deliver a reliable solution in an international market.

The STP is designed around MBBR (Moving Bed Biofilm Reactor) technology, supported by tube settling, multi-grade sand filtration, activated carbon filtration and disinfection. The treatment system is designed to deliver treated water suitable for applications such as gardening, irrigation, construction and floor washing, subject to the relevant water-quality conditions.



Why this project matters

Projects in island environments such as the Maldives come with their own set of challenges: limited space, demanding operating conditions and the importance of making every drop of water count.

This project reinforces something we have always believed at Microfilter: Water treatment is not just about treating water. It is about creating a dependable system that works where and when our customers need it.

The successful execution of this project adds another international reference to our growing portfolio and strengthens our confidence in delivering complete water and wastewater treatment solutions beyond Indian shores. From Nagpur to Malé, our engineering, manufacturing and execution capabilities continue to take Microfilter closer to our vision of becoming a trusted global partner in water treatment.

Employee of the Month - Ms. Mina Bisen (Junior Account Executive)

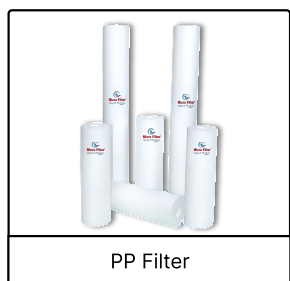


We are thrilled to recognise Ms. Mina Bisen, Account executive, as our Employee of the Month.

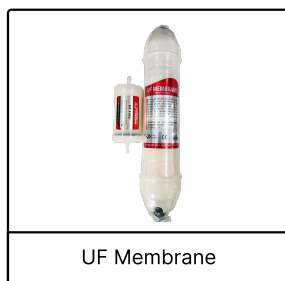

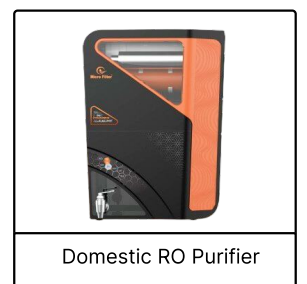
